Local Area First Responders Host the Patriot Flag At Augusta Regional Airport

Augusta, Georgia, May 13, 2011 - Local area First Responders will host World Memorial's "The Patriot Flag," on Sunday from 11 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the Augusta Regional Airport. The Patriot Flag is a tribute to the Armed Forces, First Responders, Second Responders, American Veterans, the 9/11 families and all those who perished in the terrorist attacks of Sept. 11, 2001.

World Memorial is a non-profit organization currently touring the country with the 30 x 58 foot, 75 pound commemorative flag in recognition of the 10-year anniversary of the attacks on the World Trade Center, the Pentagon and United Flight 93. The flag's journey began on September 10, 2010 in San Diego, California. The Flag's theme and message is "United We Stand and We Have Not Forgotten".

The Flag will fly in all 50 states in 50 weeks, hosted by local Fire and Police Departments and Veterans groups, before it flies over New York City, Washington D.C., and Shanksville, Pennsylvania on the tenth anniversary of the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. The Flag will then be retired in a ceremony in California where it began its journey and will be placed on display at a location to be announced.

Please join us at the Augusta Regional Airport this Sunday between 11 a.m. until 2 p.m. A banner with the names of those that died on September 11, 2001 will also be on display and a guest book will be available for visitors to sign.
