**US Airways Express to Initiate Seasonal Service from Augusta Regional
Airport to Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport**

Augusta, Georgia, December 23, 2014 — Augusta Regional Airport (AGS) is pleased to announce that US Airways will be providing non-stop seasonal service between AGS and Reagan National Airport (DCA). The Sunday through Friday once daily flight will be operated using 50 seat CRJ-200 aircraft operated by Air Wisconsin. The service will commence on March 29, 2015 and continue through June 3, 2015.

The new flight schedule is as follows:

AGS – DCA (all times local)

Departs AGS at 12:11 p.m.

Arrives DCA at 13:52 p.m.

Departs DCA at 10:00 a.m.

Arrives AGS at 11:46 a.m.

Diane Johnston, Director of Marketing & Business Development for AGS, said “The non-stop flights will provide easy passenger access to the Washington Metropolitan area with connections to other destinations in the American Airlines/US Airways domestic network. We hope the service will be well received in the community as we believe this support could lead to a return of the service in the future.”

This new DCA service is in addition to existing US Airways Express service to Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT). The airline will also operate increased frequencies to AGS from DCA, as well as incremental flying between AGS and New York’s LaGuardia Airport (LGA) and Philadelphia International Airport (PHL) during the 2015 Masters Tournament.
